I was curious about what you could do with used rubber inner tubes from the possibilities of this specific material. So, for example, I stretched a rubber inner tube around a part of an object, while another

part of the tube folded almost carelessly. The mirror, for example, illustrates this usage. This allows the forms to come into existence almost by itself. This often gives the objects an organic and natural look. Over the years I've wrapped my recreation house and outbuildings in Friesland in rubber so they have a scaly skin now.

The rubber endures the test of time, works as a form of heat insulation and the annual painting of the buildings is a thing of the past. Last but not least, I like the buildings this way.
